

**Town of Somerset
Ordinance #2004-04**

PURPOSE: An ordinance establishing a five (5) member Town Board for the Town of Somerset, consisting of unnumbered supervisor seats.

WHEREAS, the Town Electors of the Town of Somerset at the Annual Meeting held Tuesday, April 13, 2004, voted to increase the Town Board to five (5) members and ,

WHEREAS, the Town Board is authorized to adopt an ordinance to stagger the terms under WSS 60.21 (2) and

WHEREAS, the Town of Somerset five (5) member Town Board would consist of a Chairperson and four (4) Supervisors and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN OF SOMERSET BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the next general election to be held in April 2005, there will be four (4) Supervisor unnumbered seats open for re-election.
2. The four (4) open Supervisor positions will be filled; the two (2) candidates with the greatest number of votes casts (first & second) will hold two (2) year terms, and the next two (2) candidates with the greatest number of votes casts (third & fourth) will receive one (1) year terms.
3. Each year thereafter, two (2) Supervisor positions will be open for election to be two (2) year terms.

This ordinance shall be in effect and in force from and after the date of its passage and publication as required by law.
